Very Special Arts

MADISON - Applications are being accepted for the Very Special Arts Earl and Eugenia Quirk Scholarship for the fall 2004 semester. The scholarships are designed to encourage and enable graduating high school seniors with disabilities in Wisconsin to further their education in the arts and serve as role models for other young artists with and without disabilities. The deadline for applications is March 31. Recipients will be notified by May 31.

Five \$750 scholarships will be awarded to individuals with disabilities who are pursuing a degree in

the arts from an accredited college or university program of fine arts or a closely related arts-oriented field. Other criteria include letters of recommendation, demonstrated leadership, participation in community groups, extracurricular activities and financial need. While former scholarship recipients have priority, at least one graduating high school senior is selected each year.
